



Addendum to behaviour policy, in relation to **COVID-19 Guidance: Summer 2020**

In conjunction with 'Planning guide for primary schools' Published 14 May 2020- DfE

Teachers and other staff as appropriate will regularly share these rules and expectations with all children in a way that ensures the children fully understand them and can follow them.

- When arriving at school you must follow the one-way system, keeping your distance from other children and families. You must wash your hands as soon as you arrive at your classroom. Bikes, scooters and similar items will not be permitted on the school grounds.
- When leaving school you must follow the one-way system and keep your distance from other children and families- you are not permitted to use any of the areas or equipment to play on.
- You must wash your hands regularly throughout the day: which includes as a minimum before and after eating, before and after break and lunchtimes, and after going to the toilet. You must wash your hands with soap and for at least 20 seconds (Sing the tune of 'Happy Birthday' twice to help you).
- You must avoid touching your mouth, nose and eyes with your hands. If you need to sneeze or cough do this into a tissue and then put the tissue in the new lidded bin in the classroom. You must then wash your hands. Remember: 'catch it, bin it, kill it.' If you do not have a tissue you must sneeze into the inside of your elbow and wash this and your hands using soap and water as soon as possible.
- You will have a new learning group/'bubble'. You must stay with this group throughout the day. You will have learning time and playtime with this group of children.
- You will have a specific area to play in with your learning group/'bubble'. Your adults will show you where you are allowed to play and will remind you to stay in that space.
- You must follow the instructions given to you by adults for moving around the school.
- You must avoid out of bound areas.
- You must tell an adult if you are feeling unwell in any way and in particular if you have a high temperature or a new persistent cough.
- You must only use your own equipment to help you with your learning.
- Only one person may use the toilets at a time. You may only use the toilets designated to your learning group, with adult permission unless you are in Early Years. You must wash your hands after visiting the toilet for at least 20 seconds. (Sing the tune of 'Happy Birthday' twice to help you).
- You must not, at any time, cough, sneeze or spit at or towards any other person. If you cough, sneeze or spit onto anything other than a tissue you must immediately tell an adult to enable the area to be cleaned.
- You must not at any time make flippant remarks about passing on illness of any kind- including, but not limited to, Corona-virus / COVID-19
- Our usual rewards and sanction system will apply.
