## Science– States of Matter

- ◆ Identifying solids, liquids and gases..
- ◆ Observe that some materials change state when they are heated or cooled.

## Geography

- ◆ Geography: Study of volcanoes:
- ◆ What are volcanoes and where can they be found?
- ◆ Study of a volcano in a European country.
- ◆ A consideration for the impact volcanoes can have on human geography.
- ◆ Ability to read and navigate flat and model replicas of the Earth.

## RE– Judaism

- ◆ How important is it for Jewish people to do what God asks them to do?
- ◆ Learning to understand how celebrating Passover and keeping Kashrut (food laws) help Jews show God they value their special relationship with Him.

- ◆ Attempt to create a longer phrase using the conjunctions y ("and") or pero ("but").
